- Truly Plug and Play Device
Bluetooth adaptor's driver is shipped with Windows XP SP2 / Vista standard package. No extra driver needed.
- The Simplest Installation
Just plug the adaptor to available USB port of your Laptop or Desktop. Windows XP SP2 / Vista will setup the device driver automatically..


Install BlueStack from XP SP2 / Vista

1. Plug the Bluetooth adaptor to available USB port of your laptop.
2. Windows detects the Bluetooth adaptor and show Bluetooth device on system tray.

3. Right click “BT Device”, you are about to setup Bluetooth application in submenu.

Install IVT BlueSoleil

If you don't want to use the native driver which is provided by Window OS and have CD of IVT BlueSoleil, the CD will automatically activate the autorun installation program after you insert the disk into your CD drive.


Step 1 :

Insert the installation & driver CD into your CD-ROM. Prompt language during setup. Click OK to continue. Click Cancel to exit language setup page.



Step 2 :

Click **Cancel** to exit preparing page.



Step 3 : Click **Next** to install at the designated folder. Or, click “Browse” to select different folder.



Step 4 : Click **I accept the terms in the license agreement** radio button and click **Next** to continue.



Step 5 : Click **Next** to install at the designated folder. Or, click **“Change”** to select different folder.
